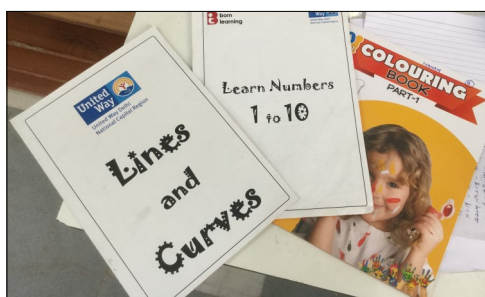


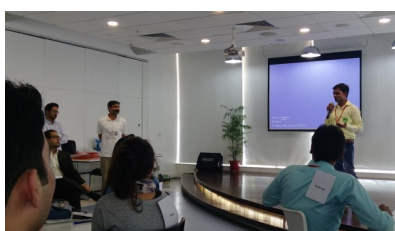
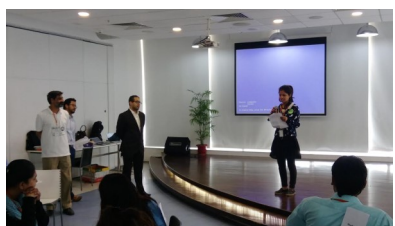

She was finding it difficult to pursue higher studies but with assistance from Jyotirgamaya Scholarship Program, she now have completed her course and looking for her final semester results.

Pooja Raju - Gold Medalist at ParaOlympics:

"I am greatly indebted to United Way Delhi and Deloitte for selecting me as a recipient of Jyotirgamaya Scholarship Program. This is tremendously helping me out in my daily practice for upcoming Olymics", says Pooja Raju. She belongs to the state of Uttar Pradesh. She left her home at an early age and later found herself at Kilkari Home by CWC. She was later admitted to Amar Jyoti School, Karkardooma. Watching her talent, the school selected her for state-level and national sports events. After being selected in the national team, she went through a series of trainings and was selected to represent India in the 2015 Special Olympics World Summer Games held at Los Angeles. She won three medals for India - gold in relay race and two silvers at 100 and 200 meter sprints. She is now a beneficiary of Jyotirgamaya Scholarship Program and preparing for Special Olympics 2019.

The objective behind this project was to empower socially and economically disadvantaged students with basic proficiency in English and cover every aspect of the intellectual, physical, academic, emotional well-being of an individual.



The program aimed at impacting school-going children in the age group of 10-16. The program inculcated good life skills, improved communication and healthy habits in students which in turn helped the children develop emotionally, physically and intellectually.

INAUGURATION OF COMPUTER LAB AND INSTALLATION OF DUAL DESK FOR SCHOOL STUDENTS

The students of SDMC Primary school located at C-block Sangam Vihar, New Delhi were enthralled by the grand inauguration of a well-equipped Computer Lab facility within the school premises in presence of SBI Cards officials and United Way Delhi team on the morning of 3rd May, 2017. This occasion also witnessed the inauguration of installation of Seven Hundred dual desks by the SBI Cards officials that were donated to the school.

The Computer Lab is equipped with twenty desktops, one server, eleven student tables and benches, teacher table, chair, projector, laptop, inverter etc. The Computer lab, donated by SBI Cards and Payment Services Pvt. Ltd. and managed by United Way Delhi, will remain open for six days a week catering to morning and afternoon batches of students.



The SBI Cards officials next were shown the Dual Desks. The officials interacted with the students and asked the students whether they are feeling happy and comfortable with the new desk in place. The dual desks provisioned by UWD are made of Marandi Wood and seat two children at a time thus benefiting four children in the double shift school.

After the mandatory ribbon cutting ceremony by the SBI Cards officials, the UWD team showed the facility to them and explained the working procedure of the facility. Mr. Birbal Meena and Rajveer Singh School Principals of both shifts and School Inspector Mr. Ram Dayal were also present on the occasion and was briefed about the facility and how UWD proposes to utilise the facility and equip the students with latest technology with the help of a computer instructor hired by UWD.

United Way of Delhi- Mobile Science Lab

United Way Delhi partnered with Agastya, a leader in creativity-based education in rural India to run this unique model of imparting science education. The Mobile science lab conducted several school visits to spread this unique initiative of learning science. 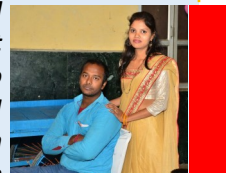

The training focused on Soft skills, Computer education and Personality development apart from

the regular course related sessions. The beneficiaries trained under the project found it useful and job oriented.

The first phase of training saw 111 students, among which 105 students completed their training successfully on 22nd December 2017. 6 students dropped out due to migration of their families.

The program aims to create economic opportunities for the unemployed youths of Chakkarpur, Gurugram, by empowering them through different job oriented vocational training.

I am Pinku and I am 28 year old. I live with my father and 4 siblings. Due to economic pressure I started looking for jobs soon after graduation but never managed to get a job. This frustrated me a lot. Meanwhile I got to know about the vocational course where I opted for Retail Associate course at no cost. I am now working with Grand Dream at Okhla as Supervisor and earning Rs. 17000/- per month.



Special Camps at Gov't Schools

Eye Camp for Students:

Around 150 students from SDMC Primary School, Bhati Mines participated in an eye camp held on 4th December, 2017. Among these students 100 were girls and 50 were boys. After computerized eye testing doctors wrote suggestions and their observations on cards corresponding to each student. CELEBRATING THE SPIRIT OF WOMEN ENTREPRENEURS

Project “**Samridhhi**” initiated in Kapashera, Delhi in April 2016, achieved new milestone with a total of 140 women now receiving support and becoming financially independent. In the last quarter, 90 new women entrepreneurs were created and 50 old entrepreneurs consolidated their businesses.

Activities undertaken

Monthly meetings

30 women attended the monthly meetings organized with the new and old beneficiaries. They discussed about their work status and registers in which they maintain daily income and expenditures details.



Celebration of Women's Day

Cargill invited 5 beneficiaries from Project Samridhhi to celebrate “**Women's Day**” in their office. The women shared their journey and experience of becoming an entrepreneur. Cargill acknowledged their efforts and felicitated them with awards. The women also interacted with renowned women working as entrepreneurs in various fields.



Health awareness session

200 women participated in 8 awareness sessions organized with support from WISH foundation. Ms. Komal facilitated sessions in which HB and blood sugar testing were done. She also advised on healthy diets and preventive measures that needs to be taken during menstruation cycles.



Boutique Visit

A visit to 3 boutiques was organized for the existing beneficiaries taking advance upskilling training on stitching. They learnt about work flow, current market trends, managing customers and communicating with customers.



Advance upskilling training

25 women in two batches participated in an advance upskilling training that was initiated for 45 days starting from 2nd Jan, 2018. These women were given knowledge to enhance their skills in stitching clothes that will help them keep with time.



Workshop on Women Safety

56 women participated in the workshop organised on 26th Feb, 2018 at chaupal, Kapashera, New Delhi. Mr. Kailash, Trainer-INVICTUS asked about the problems faced by the participants and provided necessary solutions towards the same.



SURVEY TO STUDY THE IMPACT OF PROJECT SAMRIDDHI

Students of Indian Institute of Foreign Trade (IIFT) undertook a survey to study the impact of the project. that has 44 beneficiaries. The objectives was to understand how the beneficiaries are managing money earned by them and how they are maintaining the book of accounts of their enterprises. The study captured the changes observed in socio-economic condition of the beneficiaries and their overall behavior. Impact was assessed on aspects like, Financial Management and planning, Business Development, Gender Changes, Knowledge Enhancement, Application and Impact on Life etc.

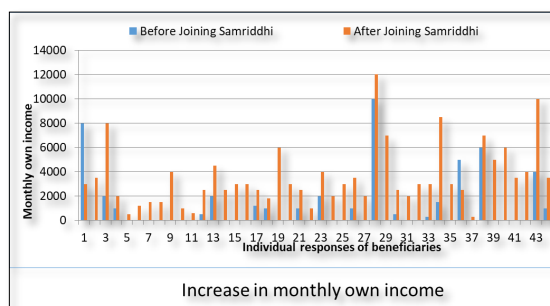

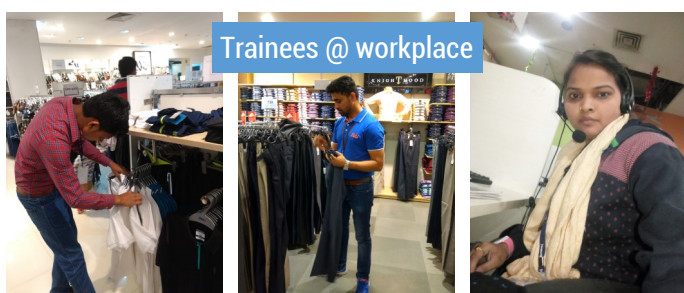


Mobilized 270 beneficiaries out of which 245 trainees successfully completed their training and 160 trainees got placement till 31st March, 2018. The trainees are drawing salary ranging from Rs.8000/- to Rs.18,000/- monthly.

Increasing water storage capacity of toilets and Grilling of water storage

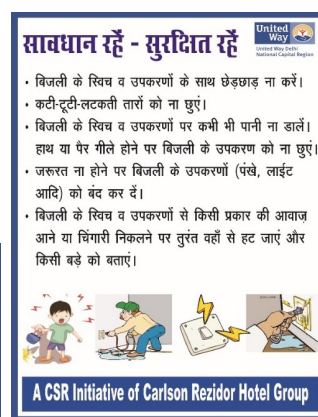
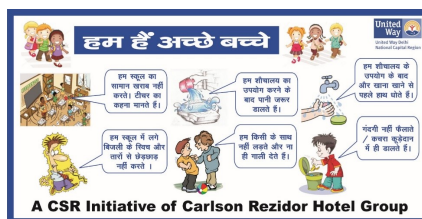

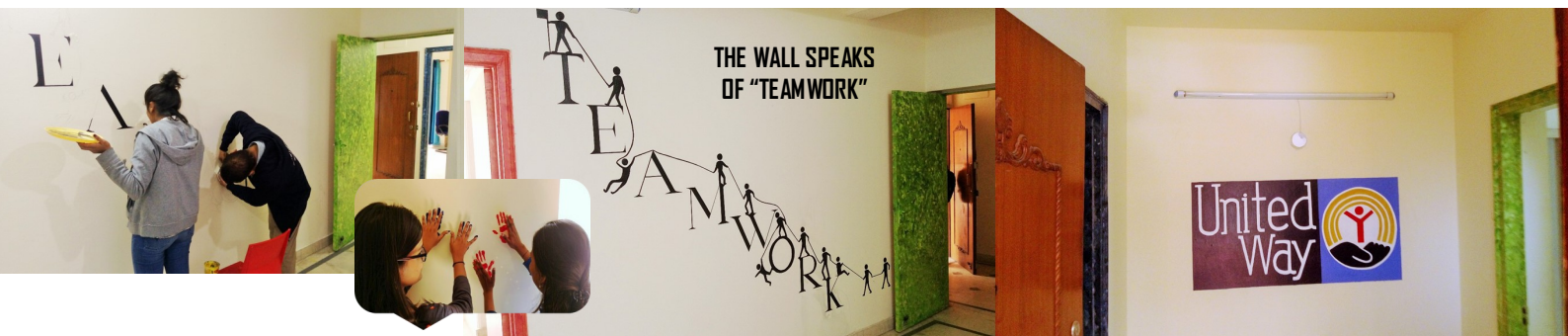
Strengthening Government Early Childhood Services one classroom at a time.

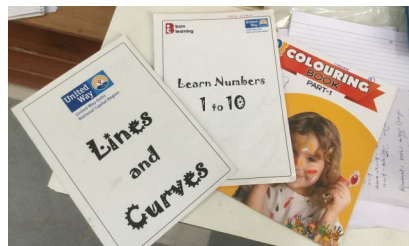
